BACKGROUND: Each year, in accordance with Public Contract Code §20169, cities that have more than one newspaper of general circulation must publish a notice inviting bids for the publication of legal notices. The City currently has two adjudicated newspapers within the City: the Weekly Calistogan, published by the Napa Valley Publishing Company, and the Calistoga Tribune. The Calistoga Tribune is the City's current provider.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: On May 19, 2017, staff published a notice inviting written bids for legal advertising to be submitted to the City Clerk by Friday, June 9, 2017 at 10 a.m. A Request for Proposal (RFP) was also sent to the Calistoga Tribune and Napa Valley Publishing Company on May 16, 2017. A proposal was received from the Calistoga Tribune on June 8, 2017 at 8:45 a.m. This was the only proposal received.

Criterion #1: <u>Completeness of proposal and responsiveness to the RFP</u>. Staff determined the proposal to be complete and responsive to the RFP.

Criterion #2: <u>Compliance with State and Federal Requirements</u>. State law requires publication of legal notices in a "newspaper of general circulation." The Calistoga Tribune meets this requirement of the State definition and the Federal requirement for publication of notices for projects or programs utilizing grant funding.

Criterion #3: <u>Circulation and Coverage</u>. The U.S. Postal Service "CASS Summary Report" (Form PS 3553) which was filed for the period of April 15, 2017 states that Calistoga Tribune's total Records Submitted for Processing was 879.

Criterion #4: <u>Frequency of Publication</u>. The Calistoga Tribune publishes one time per week (Fridays).

Criterion #5: <u>Cost</u>. The Calistoga Tribune prepared a sample legal advertisement and display advertisement and provided the cost to run each ad. The Calistoga Tribune proposes to charge \$12.25 per column inch for legal notices and display advertisements. The sample legal notice resulted in a cost of \$84.53. The sample display advertisement resulted in \$73.50.

consistency with city council goals and objectives: The recommended action supports the FY 2017/18 City Council Goal No. 2, Objective 1 by complying with Public Contract Code §20169 "...cities that have more than one newspaper of general circulation must publish a notice inviting bids for the publication of legal notices" to "...maintain current City services and operating costs at the most economically viable levels commensurate with equal service levels." It also is consistent with Goal No. 2, Objective No. 3 'Promote and enhance communication and transparency."

FISCAL IMPACT: The estimated cost for publishing legal notices and display advertisements in Fiscal Year 2017/2018 is \$15,000, which is included in the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 budget. There is usually additional cost for publishing legal notices for development projects (which are paid for by the applicant).

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2017, the City filed a Notice Inviting Written Bids for Legal Advertising, said bids to be submitted by Friday, June 9, 2017 at 10:00 A.M.; and

WHEREAS, the City determined that the Calistoga Tribune's proposal is the only proposal received and is complete and responsive; and

WHEREAS, the City Council independently reviewed the staff report and bid proposal at its June 20, 2017, regular meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Calistoga Tribune for Citywide legal advertising.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Calistoga hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement substantially in accordance with the attached Professional Services Agreement for publication of legal notices and legal advertisements with the Calistoga Tribune in an amount not to exceed \$15,000, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
