ISSUE: Consideration of a Resolution that:

- 1. Conditionally awards the construction contract to Granite Construction Company for the Berry Street Bridge Replacement Project (Project) in the amount of \$3,893,954, subject to Granite Construction Company providing all documents in satisfaction of the bid award requirements, and contingent upon receipt of a revised E-76 from Caltrans for additional construction costs.
- 2. Approves the Project construction budget in the amount of \$4,867,442 which includes Construction Management costs of 15% of the bid amount and a contingency of 10% of the bid amount and authorizes the Public Works Director to negotiate and approve contract change orders up to the approved construction budget amount and approves a Budget Adjustment in an amount of \$2,230,952 reflecting the revised Project costs.
- 3. Authorizes the City Manager to execute the Project contract on behalf of the City of Calistoga.
- 4. Directs staff to issue a notice of award to Granite Construction Company and otherwise administer the Project.

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5. In the event Granite Construction Company is unable to meet the conditions of award, awards the construction contract to Gordon N. Ball, Inc. conditioned upon Gordon N. Ball, Inc. providing all documents in satisfaction of the bid award requirements, and contingent upon receipt of a revised E-76 from Caltrans for additional construction costs.

6. Council waives any informalities or irregularities in the bids

Gordon N. Ball, Inc. – Alamo, CA

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

BACKGROUND: A notice inviting bids for construction of the Berry Street Bridge was advertised on May 19, 2017 with bids due on June 13, 2017. Two bids were received as follows:

1. Granite Construction Company – Ukiah, CA \$3,893,954

Staff has reviewed the low bid proposal from Granite Construction Company and has performed due diligence to verify the information presented. Based on the reference checks staff recommends that the City Council find Granite Construction Company to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

\$3,940,392

The permit from Fish and Wildlife requires that all work performed in the Napa River be completed by October 15, 2017. As such it is essential that work commence as soon as possible. Staff anticipates construction to begin in early July. The Contractor anticipates installing the temporary pedestrian bridge and utilities this construction year and remove and replace the bridge next summer, unless they feel confident they can get all in-water work completed before October 15th.

GENERAL PLAN CONSISTENCY:

The project is consistent with General Plan Section 7 - Infrastructure – Circulation, Part F – Goals, objectives, policies and actions, which provide as follows:

Goal CIR-1 – Maintain and enhance Calistoga's street network to serve existing and planned land uses while also maintaining the community's small-town character.

Objective CIR-1.1 – Develop Calistoga's street network of arterials, collectors, primary local and local streets as discussed in Section C of the Circulation Element.

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<u>CEQA/NEPA PERMIT COMPLIANCE</u>: A CEQA Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration, and NEPA Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact for the project have been completed and permits have been obtained to build the project. Permits include: US Army Corp (404), DFW (1600 and Initial Take permit), USFW/NMS (authorization from biological tech memos), State Water Resource Control Board permit (401), State Lands Commission (lease for sovereign land).

FISCAL IMPACT: The Berry Street Bridge Replacement Project is included in the FY 2017/18 Budget and funded under Account #25-5518-4915 in the amount of \$2,636,490. Both construction proposals came in higher than the engineers construction cost estimate of \$2,200,000, indicating that the bid results are reflecting the "higher cost" construction climate in the state right now. The recommended Resolution includes a Budget Adjustment in the amount of \$2,230,952 under Account #25-5518-4915 for the expenditure and Account 25-3230 for the additional grant proceeds, reflecting the revised budget amount.

Additional construction funds have been requested from our grant funding source. All expenditures including the increased costs will be funded 100% through the HBP and State Bridge Toll Credit grant the City was successful in obtaining.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CONDITIONALLY AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,893,954 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE BERRY STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, APPROVING A BUDGET ADJUSTMENT IN AN AMOUNT OF \$2,230,952 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Berry Street Bridge has been identified as being in critical need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City's adopted FY 2017/18 CIP Budget contains \$2,636,490 in unencumbered appropriations for this Project under Account 25-5518-4915; and

WHEREAS, CEQA and NEPA has been completed and all permits obtained; and

WHEREAS, a request for bids was circulated on May 19, 2017 and two bids were received by the City, with the low bidder being Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$3,893,954 and the second lowest bid was from Gordon N. Ball, Inc. in the amount of \$3,940,392; and

WHEREAS, City staff has confirmed that the bid from Granite Construction Company satisfies the bidding requirements for the Project as described in the bid instructions; and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that Granite Construction Company possesses the required license(s) for this Project and is otherwise qualified to perform the Project in accordance with the Contract documents; and

WHEREAS, staff has confirmed that the bid from Gordon N. Ball, Inc. also satisfies the bidding requirements for the Project as described in the bid instructions and that Gordon N. Ball, Inc. is also otherwise qualified to perform the Project in accordance with the Contract documents; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed the bid from Granite Construction Company and recommends that the City Council find that Granite Construction Company is the lowest responsible and responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the bid be awarded to Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$3,893,954contingent upon receipt of a revised E-76 from Caltrans for the additional construction costs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Calistoga as follows:

- 1. Approves the Project plans and specifications.
- 2. Finds that the bid from Granite Construction Company is the lowest responsive bid and is a responsible bidder and waives any and all minor bid irregularities.
- 3. Approves the Project construction budget in the amount of \$4,867,442, which includes construction management of 15% of the bid amount and a contingency of 10% of the bid amount and authorizes the Public Works Director/City Engineer to negotiate and approve contract change orders up to the approved construction budget amount.
- 4. Approves a Budget Adjustment of \$2,230,952 increasing appropriations in Account 25-5518-4915 and 25-3230 to \$4,867,442.
- 5. Awards the construction contract to Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$3,893,954 for construction of the Berry Street Bridge Replacement Project conditioned upon Granite Construction Company providing all documents in satisfaction of the bid award requirements, and contingent upon receipt of a revised E-76 from Caltrans for the additional construction costs.
- 6. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the City of Calistoga.
- 7. Directs staff to issue a notice of award to Granite Construction Company and otherwise administer the Project.
- 8. In the event Granite Construction Company is unable to satisfy the bid award requirements, awards the construction contract to Gordon N. Ball, Inc. under the same requirements, and authorizes the commensurate increase in expenditures from CIP Account 25-5518-4915 to fund the Project.
