ISSUE: Consideration of a Resolution that:

- 1. Conditionally awards the construction contract to Argonaut Constructors for the Lake Street Pavement Rehabilitation Project (Project) in the amount of \$353,679.50, subject to Argonaut Constructors providing all documents in satisfaction of the bid award requirements.
- 2. Approves the Project construction budget in the amount of \$ 404,100 which includes a contingency of 10% of the bid amount, construction inspection and authorizes the Public Works Director to negotiate and approve contract change orders up to the approved construction budget amount.
- 3. Authorizes the City Manager to execute the Project contract on behalf of the City of Calistoga.
- 4. Directs staff to issue a notice of award to Argonaut Constructors and otherwise administer the Project.
- In the event Argonaut Constructors is unable to meet the conditions of award, awards the construction contract to G. D. Nielson Construction, Inc. conditioned upon G. D. Construction, Inc. providing all documents in satisfaction of the bid award requirements.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION: As part of the City's Pavement Management System bi-annual inspection, several concrete streets were noted that required rehabilitation. Plans were prepared by BKF Engineers, Inc. for the project and the project was put out to bid in August 2017. On August 29, 2017 bids were opened pursuant to the August 4, 2017 notice to bidders. The City received three bids, which are summarized as follows:

Argonaut Constructors	Santa Rosa, CA	\$353,679.50
2. G. D. Nielson Construction	Napa, CA	\$377,387.00
3. Martin Brothers Construction	Sacramento, CA	\$414,862.25

Staff has reviewed the low bid proposal from Argonaut Constructors and has performed due diligence to verify the information presented. Based on the reference checks staff recommends that the City Council find Argonaut Constructors to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

<u>COUNCIL GOALS</u>: The project conforms to Council Goal 3: Establish, improve and maintain City infrastructure.

<u>CEQA REVIEW</u>: The project involves the replacement and reconstruction of a portion of the existing roadways infrastructure and will be located on the same site, will have the same purposes and transportation capacity as the roadway resurfaced and will have no expansion of the carrying capacity of the vehicular transportation system. As such the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Title 14, the California Code of Regulations, Section 15302(c).

FISCAL IMPACT: This Project is included in the adopted Fiscal Year 2017/18 CIP budget which includes funds for this project under Account #01-5402-4915 with an unencumbered fund balance of approximately \$1,745,000.
