- 8 The following items are subject to review by the Planning and Building Director:
 - Additions of less than 10 percent of the gross floor area to an existing structure
- Minor exterior alterations to an existing structure
 - Minor site modifications
- The following items are subject to review by the Planning Commission:
 - Construction of structures
 - Additions of more than 10 percent of the gross floor area to an existing structure
 - Substantial exterior modifications to an existing structure
- Design review approval is not required for the following:
 - Alterations of buildings where the work is in an area not visible from the public right-of-way or accessible to the public, as determined by the Director of Planning and Building.

- Construction and building modifications determined by the Director of Planning and Building to raise no substantial design issues in conflict with those outlined in CMC 17.41.010 (Purposes of Design Review) and 17.41.050 (Required Findings). In these instances, the Director may waive the requirement for design review and may ensure compliance with this title [Zoning Code] through review of the plans submitted for a building permit.
- Commercial projects that have been reviewed by the Planning Commission or staff since May 2014 are summarized in Attachment 1.

- 29 Planning Commission and staff review of commercial projects is guided, in part, by the
- 30 Community Identity Element of the Calistoga General Plan, which contains design-
- oriented goals, objectives and policies.
- 32 Additionally, the Land Use Element includes detailed development and design

- and character areas, which are considered during design review.

- Planning Department staff often meets with applicants before a design review application
- is submitted to identify and discuss design elements that may be of concern based on
- 38 General Plan guidance and individual circumstances (such as a prevailing neighborhood
- 39 character).

- 40 Applicants for complex projects are encouraged to present conceptual plans to the
- Planning Commission for feedback prior to filing a formal application.
