SUBJECT: Consideration of a Resolution Establishing A No Parking Zone on

Lincoln Avenue Adjacent to the Depot Shopping Center.

APPROVAL FOR FORWARDING:

ISSUE: Consideration of a Resolution establishing a No Parking zone on Lincoln Avenue adjacent to the Depot shopping center to improve traffic safety pursuant to Section 10.36.030(B) of the Calistoga Municipal Code, to improve transit bus service, and directing the Public Works Director to install the necessary No Parking signs and red curb. Also directing the Police Department to begin enforcement after the signs have been installed.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION: The Napa Valley Transportation Authority operates the Vine Transit bus system which includes regular and express service between Calistoga, St. Helena, Yountville and Napa. There are five designated bus stops in Calistoga: one on each side of the Lincoln Avenue Bridge over the Napa River, one each near Cal Mart, the Depot and at Brannan Street near Lincoln.

Due to the Lincoln Avenue Bridge construction NVTA has temporarily suspended service at those two bus stops. To improve efficiency and reduce route times NVTA is also planning on relocating all downtown service to the Depot bus stop only. The Brannan Street bus stop would continue to be in service. After

stopping at Brannan Street, the bus would continue to Silverado Trail and then south to Dunaweal and back to Hwy. 29.

To provide safe access for the east bound bus and to minimize conflicts between the buses and general traffic it is recommended to post a No Parking Zone at the two parking spaces on Lincoln nearest Fair Way Extension. Section 10.36.030(B) of the Calistoga Municipal Code allows the City Council to establish No Parking zones if the area in question constitutes a traffic hazard.

CONSISTENCY WITH CITY COUNCIL GOALS AND OBJECTIVES: The recommended action supports FY 2017/18 City Council Goal No. 3, Objective 7, "...Improve all forms of transportation". Modifying the Vine Transit route/schedule will reduce headway time between Calistoga and down valley destinations and improve the bus rider experience.

FISCAL IMPACT: The cost to purchase and install the required signs and red curb on Lincoln Ave. is approximately \$400 and will come from account 01-4122-4401.
