ISSUE: Consideration of a Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to sign a Settlement Agreement against WMB Contractors for Liquidated Damages Regarding the Monhoff Center Restoration Project.

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RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution.

BACKGROUND: The Monhoff Center Restoration Project ("Project") was awarded to WMB General Contractors on August 2, 2016, and a Notice to Proceed was issued on August 30, 2016. Pursuant to the Notice to Proceed, the Project was to be substantially completed within 90 calendar days of August 30, 2016. Therefore, the Contract completion date was November 29, 2016.

 Per Section 00500 (Contract for Construction) of the Contract between the City and WMB ("Contract"), the Contract "may be amended only by written instrument." Similarly, per the Contract's Change Order Procedure (Section 01035), changes in the Time of Completion called for under the Contract are to be done through a change order.

Portions of the Project's scope of work changed during the course of construction. Termite and mold damage, new service panels, new electrical and perimeter wall repairs all led to additional work that was not originally contemplated by the Contract. The City approved a total of 10 change orders on the Project, and WMB requested an additional 72 days to complete the work. All additional time that was requested by WMB through a change order as required by the Contract as approved by the City. The final change order approved by the City listed the total time for completion of the Project as 162 days.

The City Building Official issued a Temporary Certificate of Occupancy on June 29, 2017, which put the time of substantial completion of the Project at 303 days, 141 days beyond the approved time of construction. Per the Contract, liquidated damages are

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set at \$800 for every calendar days' delay beyond the time prescribed to complete the work.

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35 36 The City Manager and City Attorney approached WMB to discuss a settlement for liquidated damages rather than pursue litigation. Currently, the City has \$46,409.80 in retention, and \$10,079.80 is currently unpaid on the Contract, for a total of \$56,489.60 (collectively the "Retained Funds").

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40 41 Within 30 days of the effective date of the Settlement Agreement, the City shall issue and deliver a check to WMB from the Retained Funds for \$16,489.60. The City shall withhold and keep \$40,000 of the Retained Funds, which shall constitute the Settlement Payment.
