BACKGROUND: Since November 2016, the City has been studying water and wastewater utility rates required to sufficiently fund the City's enterprise funds. Beginning in November 2017, City Council has held six (6) public meetings including a Community Forum to collect feedback and input from residents.

On January 2, 2018, Council held a Public Hearing regarding the water and wastewater funds, their financial status and options to address concerns.

On February 6th, Council provided direction to staff to include an additional \$15,000, bringing it to a total of \$30,000, in the water enterprise fund to serve as low-income assistance to low income customers.
