**ISSUE:** Consideration of approving two (2) Resolutions in support of Proposition 68 and Proposition 69 appearing on the June 5, 2018 ballot.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The June 2018 statewide election ballot information has been posted on the Secretary of State website. The League of California Cities has requested the City of Calistoga formally support two (2) of the initiatives that will appear on the June 5<sup>th</sup> ballot, Propositions 68 and 69.

Proposition 68 - California Drought, Water, Parks, Climate, Costal Protection, and Outdoor Access for All Act of 2018, a.k.a. SB 5 (De Leon – 2017) or simply the 2018 Park/Water Bond.

This was passed by the legislature on September 16, 2017, SB 5 – now known as Proposition 68 – was signed by the Governor to place a \$4 billion bond on the June 2018 ballot that would fund parks, water, climate and environmental programs. If the voters approve Proposition 68, local governments would receive funding for local park improvements and will be eligible for grants to fund water,

local parks, coastal and climate resiliency projects. 21

Proposition 69 – Motor Vehicle Fees and Taxes: Restrictions on expenditures: appropriations limit, a.k.a. ACA 5 (Frazier, 2017).

This was passed by the legislature on April 6, 2017, CAC 5 (Frazier) – now known as Proposition 69 – was part of the agreement to secure passage of SB1, he transportation funding proposal which is now law. Proposition 69 will prohibit the legislature from raiding any of these new transportation funds and ensures that these funds cannot be borrowed or diverted by the legislature and can only be used for transportation purposes.
