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ISSUE: Consideration of a Resolution to rescind Resolution No. 2016-018 and to adopt a revised Conflict of Interest Code.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The Political Reform Act requests every local government agency to review its conflict-of-interest code every two (2) years. No later than the end of each even numbered year, each agency must submit to the code reviewing body (City Council) a memorandum indicating whether an amendment is necessary.

The Sr. Planner/Assistant to the City Manager position is not presently listed in the City of Calistoga Conflict of Interest Code, therefore an amendment is being submitted to the code reviewing body.

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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2016-018 AND ADOPTING A REVISED CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE CITY OF CALISTOGA.

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code commencing with Section 87300, the City Council is required to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code: and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 87302, the Conflict of Interest Code shall provide for specific enumeration of the positions within the City. other than those specified in Government Code Section 87200, which involve the making or participation in the making of decisions which may foreseeably have material effect on any financial interest and for each such enumerated position, the specific types of investments, business position interests in real property and sources of income which must be reported; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") has adopted a regulation (Fair Political Practices Commission, Title 2, Div 6, California Code of Regulations Section 18730), which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be incorporated by reference and which may be amended by the FPPC to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calistoga has previously incorporated by reference the FPPC's standard conflict of interest code in the City's Conflict of Interest Code; and

WHEREAS, incorporation by reference of the terms of the aforementioned regulation and amendments thereto in the Conflict of Interest Code of the City of Calistoga will save the Calistoga City Council time and money by minimizing the actions required of that body to keep its code in conformity with the Political Reform Act: and

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act requires review of the Conflict of Interest Code every two (2) years to determine whether it is accurate or whether it should be amended; and

WHEREAS, the Sr. Planner/Assistant to the City Manager position is not presently listed in the City of Calistoga Conflict of Interest, therefore an amendment reflecting the addition to the Designation Positions (Appendix A) shall be submitted to the code reviewing body; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update its current Conflict of Interest Code to revise the list of designated positions and disclosure categories.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1. Resolution No. 2016-018 adopted March 1, 2016, is hereby rescinded.

Section 2. The terms of 2 California Code of Regulations, Section 18730 and any and all amendments to it adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, as well as the attached Appendices A & B in which officials and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, are hereby incorporated by reference. This Resolution shall constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the City of Calistoga. Section 3. Designated committee members shall file Statements of Economic Interests (Form 700) with the City Clerk, to whom the City Council hereby designates the authority to carry out the duties of the Filing Officer. **Section 4.** The effective date of this Code shall be the date this Code is originally approved and adopted by the City Council. Section 5. Statements of Economic Interest shall be made on forms prescribed by the Fair Political Practices Commission and supplied by the City of Calistoga. Individuals holding one of these positions may contact the Fair Political Practices Commission for assistance or written advice regarding their filing obligations if they believe that their position has been categorized incorrectly. The Fair Political Practices Commission makes the final determination as to whether or not a position is covered by Government Code Section 87200.

* The City Manager may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated employee," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this Code. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The City Manager's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.

** Government Code Section 87200 is applicable to "members of planning commissions, . . . mayors, city managers, city attorneys, city treasurers, chief administrative officers and members of city councils of cities and other public officials who manage public investments"

163 164 **APPENDIX B** 165 166 167 168 **DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES** 169 The "designated employee" disclosing investments and sources of income need only 170 disclose investments in businesses and sources of income which do business in the 171 City of Calistoga (City), plan to do business in the City or have done business in the City 172 within the past two years. In addition to other activities, a business entity is doing 173 174 business within the City if it owns real property within the City. 175 When a "designated employee" is disclosing interests in real property, the employee 176 177 need only disclose the interest in real property which is located in whole or part within or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the City or within two miles of any 178 land owned or used by the City. 179 180 Designated employees shall disclose their financial interests pursuant to the appropriate 181 disclosure category as indicated in Appendix A. 182 183 Category 1: All investments and sources of income. 184 185 Category 2: All interests in real property. 186 187 Category 3. All investments, interests in real property, and sources of income subject 188 to the regulatory, permit, or licensing authority of the department. 189 190 Category 4: Investments in business entities and business positions and sources of 191 income which engage in land development, construction, or the acquisition 192 or sale of real property. 193 194 Category 5: Investments in business entities and business positions and sources of 195 income of the type which, within the past two years, have contracted with 196 the City of Calistoga to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery, 197 or equipment. 198 199 Category 6: Investments in business entities and business positions and sources of 200 income of the type which, within the past two years, have contracted with 201 the designated employee's department to provide services, supplies, 202 materials, machinery, or equipment. 203
