- 1 **ISSUE:** Annual report on the status of the Calistoga General Plan and progress made
- 2 toward its implementation during 2017
- 3 **RECOMMENDATION:** Accept the annual report and direct staff to file it with the
- 4 appropriate state agencies
- 5 **BACKGROUND**: The Calistoga General Plan serves two primary functions. As an
- 6 information document, it describes existing conditions within the city and provides
- 7 development projections. As a policy document, the General Plan establishes a vision
- 8 for the community's future and guidelines for decision-makers through goals, objectives,
- 9 policies and actions.
- 10 Using these guidelines, the Calistoga City Council, Planning Commission and Active
- 11 Transportation Advisory Committee take incremental steps toward achieving the larger
- goals of the City. City staff also implements policies and actions contained in the
- General Plan through day-to-day operations of the City.
- The State requires the City to submit an annual report on the status of its general plan
- and progress made toward its implementation to the City Council, the Governor's Office
- of Planning and Research and the California Department of Housing and Community
- Development. The report also identifies how City decision-making was guided by the
- 18 General Plan's goals, policies and actions.

19 **DISCUSSION**

- 20 Status of the Calistoga General Plan
- 21 The Calistoga General Plan was comprehensively updated in 2003. Several of its

- seven State-mandated elements have been comprehensively updated since then:
 - Housing Element (2014)

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- Circulation Element (2014)
- Public Safety Element (2014)
- Land Use Element (2012)
- Staff is currently updating the Infrastructure Element, which addresses water facilities and service, wastewater collection and treatment, water reclamation and stormwater collection. A substantial amount of information in this element needs to be updated to reflect improvements made since its original adoption in 2003.
- 31 General Plan implementation during 2017
- Actions that were taken by the City during 2017 to implement the General Plan are summarized by element in Attachments 1 and 2.
- The General Plan was not amended during 2017.
- 35 General Plan amendments and implementation anticipated during 2018
- Efforts to implement the General Plan that are anticipated during 2018 are summarized in Attachment 1.
- In addition to updating the Infrastructure Element, Staff recommends updating the Economic Development and Geothermal Elements during 2018 for the following reasons:
 - The Economic Development Element includes actions intended to help reduce unemployment, which is no longer a significant issue for the City. It also calls for the development of high-end visitor accommodations, which have or will soon be added to the community's inventory of visitor accommodations. The Element needs to be updated to address current economic development challenges and identify appropriate strategies.
 - The City is no longer pursuing the conservation of the local volcanic ash supply, as called for in the Geothermal Element, and is actively working to reduce its use by spas. Other measures have been implemented and no longer need to be included in the Element.
- PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION: At its March 14, 2018 meeting, the Calistoga Planning Commission recommended to the City Council acceptance of the annual report on the General Plan.
- ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW: The annual report on the General Plan is not a project and is therefore not subject to environmental review.
- FISCAL IMPACT: The annual report itself has no fiscal impacts. The fiscal impacts of each General Plan action will be determined at the time of its implementation.
