Year 2018/19

<u>ISSUE</u>: Consideration of a Resolution Approving Senate Bill 1 Street Improvement Project List for Implementation in Fiscal Year 2018/19 and Authorizing the Staff to submit the Same to the California Transportation Commission (CTC).

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the resolution.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION: On April 28, 2017, the Governor signed Senate Bill 1 (SB1) to address basic road maintenance needs on local roads and state highways. SB1 increases the fuel excise taxes and vehicle registration fees with an annual inflation adjustment in future years. Starting November 1, 2017, the State Controller began collecting the revenues generated by SB1 and placed the revenues into a newly created Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) for distribution to local agencies. The funds are for eligible street improvement projects that address maintenance, rehabilitation and critical safety projects on local streets.

SB1 requires that agencies provide an annual local match, from general fund revenues, called maintenance of effort (MOE) to be eligible to receive SB1 funding. The State has determined that the City's MOE is \$273,756. Current estimates are that Calistoga will

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receive approximately \$99,400 in SB1 funding for FY 2018/19. The annual amount of SB1 revenue will vary depending on fuel consumption.

In order to be eligible for continued SB1 funding, local agencies are required to submit to the CTC on or before May 1 of every year a Resolution adopting a list of proposed projects planned to be constructed the next fiscal year using SB1 funding. This will be an ongoing annual requirement.

As part of the Measure T requirements the Council recently approved a five year expenditure plan. The recommended SB1 Resolution mirrors the Measure T work plan for FY 2018/19.

CONSISTENCY WITH CITY COUNCIL GOALS AND OBJECTIVES: The project conforms to Council Goal 3: Establish, improve and maintain City infrastructure; Objectives 3 and 4 – 'Provide for long term maintenance and repair of City sidewalks' and 'Support efforts to fund bridge and street maintenance and repair.'

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW: The recommended action described in this report are not in-and-of-themselves a "project" pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15378) since they do not result in a physical change in the environment.

Furthermore, the projects identified are exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 as repair, maintenance or minor alteration of existing facilities involving no or negligible expansion of use beyond that which presently exists.

FISCAL IMPACT: Funds for the recommended projects will be included in the proposed FY 2018/19 Budget under CIP Pavement Maintenance.

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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA APPROVING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND **ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017: AND DETERMINNING THAT THE ACTION AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION ARE EXEMPT FROM** THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City/County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Calistoga must adopt a list of projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1 by resolution, which must include a description, location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, Calistoga will receive and estimated \$99,400 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2018-19 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the second year in which Calistoga is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable Calistoga to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects. safety improvements, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the Calistoga has previously conducted a public hearing to ensure public input for the prosed project list; and

WHEREAS, Calistoga used the 2017 Pavement Condition Index (PCI) Report to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used to improve the City's PCI; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that Calistoga's roads vary in condition from 19% very poor up to 27% in very good condition and the SB 1 will help to improve the overall quality of our road system; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 funding will help Calistoga rehabilitate critical streets this year and numerous similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the projects anticipated to be funded by SB1 revenues are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 because they are repair, maintenance or minor alteration of existing facilities involving no or negligible expansion of use beyond that which presently exists; and

WHEREAS, the proposed SB1 projects will comply with the requirements under the CEQA (California Code Sections 21000 et seg.; as implemented through California Regulations Title 14, Chapter 3, Sections 15000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, The Calistoga City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at a public meeting of the City Council, including any supporting reports by City staff, and any information provided during the public meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Calistoga as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct, and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.
- 2. The City Council finds that the projects anticipated to be funded by SB 1 revenues are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 because they are repair, maintenance or minor alteration of existing facilities involving no or negligible expansion of use beyond that which presently exists.
- 3. The City Council hereby adopts the FY 2018/19 SB 1 project list for the City of Calistoga as set forth in Exhibit A and authorizes the Public Works Director to file the list with CTC in accordance with SB 1 guidelines.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
