Sexual Assault Victim Services Bilingual Advocate Araceli Vargas and Program Manager Judy Durham accepted the proclamation representing Napa Emergency Women Services (N.E.W.S.). Ms. Durham spoke of the N.E.W.S. About Sports campaign launch.
 - 2) Mayor Canning presented a proclamation declaring April 2018 as Arts In April Month. Carlene Moore accepted the award. Ms. Moore gave a short presentation regarding the Sarafornia Event.
 - 3) Oaths of office were given to Fire Fighters Keegan Barrett, Blake McCormick, Jason Pierson and Ryan Smithers by City Clerk Flamson.
 - 4) Registrar of Voters John Tuteur gave a presentation on the Voters Choice Act, noting Napa County is one of 5 counties in California implementing this pilot program. Every registered voter will receive a vote-by-mail ballot. Voters can register to vote up to and including the day of voting. There will be ballot drop boxes open 28 days before the election for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. He also noted Vote Centers will take the place of polling places. The Calistoga Vote Center will be located at the Calistoga Fire Station. He also asked for citizens over 18-years-old to staff the polling places. Individuals can apply on line for these jobs.
