BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

In 1998, the City of Calistoga established a teen center program as a program offered by the Recreation Division. The purpose for the program was to provide a structured, safe and supervised place for teens to "hang out" during after school hours. Recreation staff provided staffing for the program which was conducted after school from 3:30 pm until 9:00 pm. Activities consisted of playing billiards, video games, sports activities and other similar type events. This program was instrumental in keeping many of our at-risk youth occupied with activities and thus, keeping them out of trouble.

In 2004, the City partnered with the Boys & Girls Club of St. Helena and Calistoga (B&GC) to offer the program to youth whereby the service provider would become the B&GC. The Boys & Girls Clubs of St. Helena and Calistoga primarily serve children and families in the upper Napa Valley and have expanded and enhanced their program offerings in Calistoga. On Saturday, October 7, 2017, the new Boys & Girls Clubhouse facility was opened to the community in front of a large crowd. The new facility provides space for learning, arts, sports, technology and endless uses which will benefit kids and families for decades to come. In addition, the City recently completed

a remodel of the Monhoff Center where Teen Center programs and activities are provided.

A Professional Services Agreement was developed in 2004 and over the years, the City has provided \$30,000 per year to the B&GC for offering the Teen Center programs to our community. Due to increased programs and services, the City has drafted a new agreement which specifies the scope of work to be performed, estimated outcomes which can be achieved, and provides an additional \$10,000 to the B&GC for their program costs. The total amount of this contract is \$40,000 annually and can be renewed each year by the city manager (following Council budget appropriation).

The City's partnership with the Boys & Girls Club remains a mutually beneficial arrangement that meets the needs of youth and working parents to create a positive place for Calistoga youngsters to learn and play. The partnership addresses three of the City Council goals, 1) Consolidate services where appropriate 2) Enhance recreation opportunities 3) Expand youth services and recreation opportunities. Our Recreation Division staff would continue to concentrate on providing recreational and sports programs to our youth and have the added opportunity to collaborate with the Boys & Girls Club staff on many new projects and programs.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$40,000.00 from account number 01-4107-4487. This amount is included in the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Budget.

WHEREAS, the stated goals of the City Council are to partnership/consolidate services where appropriate, enhance recreation opportunities and expand youth services and recreation opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the amount of \$40,000 is included in the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget in account number 01-4107-4487.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Calistoga does hereby approve a Professional Services Agreement with the Boys & Girls Club of St. Helena and Calistoga for the operation of the Calistoga Teen Center. A copy of said Agreement is attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement in substantially the same form as that attached.
