**BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:** The current police department radio system. Positron Power Radio System, is approximately 15 years old and is failing. The Positron Power Radio is an integrated radio system that manages various functions in addition to controlling radio transmissions to officers such as facilitating the dispatchers' ability to answer the 911 and business phones. controlling the department's electronic door lock system (front door, back door, and jail door) and sally port gates, and sending out the fire alert tone (to notify Fire Personnel of an impending fire/medical call).

The current system is not covered under a maintenance contract due to its age, the vendor no longer makes parts for the system, and there are no used parts available. The AT&T technicians who provide maintenance service have described the need to replace the dispatch radio console system as critical. The radio system is failing as dispatchers intermittently lose their ability to answer the 911 and business line phone system. Dispatchers in these cases have to scramble to exchange the battery in the headset to connect to the call. phone lines no longer works. The same intermittent issues occur when dispatching calls to officers or responding to requests from officers via the radio.

These issues cause unnecessary delays and pose a public and officer safety risk. There are two other ways for dispatchers to communicate with officers when there is a failure with the radio console, 1) using a portable radio which does not have same level of transmission range or 2) using the county desktop console which is older than the Positron Radio console and only has the radio capability to broadcast on our channel, meaning we have no radio interoperability with other allied agencies or our own Fire Department via their channel.

As a result of the condition of our current radio system, the police department identified three radio console systems and obtained bids. The systems identified were the Telex Csoft Console, the Motorola MIP5000 Console, and the Avtec Scout Dispatch System (see attached specifications & quotes). In addition to Calistoga Police Department (CPD) dispatch staff, the three specifications were reviewed, and input provided by Napa County Communications and AT&T technicians who assist in trouble shooting and providing some level of maintenance service between the dispatch radio console, 911 & phone lines, and other allied radio channels.

 Napa County Communications and AT&T technicians who are familiar with all three systems unanimously recommended the Avtec Scout system as it is the system that Napa County Communications and St. Helena Police dispatch use. The AT&T technicians added that they worked with the other two systems and found that they encountered a number of glitches and integration issues with the 911 and phone line functions which required multiple maintenance visits to troubleshoot ongoing problems. CPD dispatch staff support the recommendation provided by both Napa County Communications and the AT&T technicians assigned to our area.

<u>CONSISTENCY WITH CITY COUNCIL GOALS AND OBJECTIVES</u>: This request supports and furthers the City Council's Goal of "Offer excellent professional services to all customers".

FISCAL IMPACT: The cost of purchasing, installing, and training staff on the Avtec Scout System is approximately \$89,293.60. The need to replace the aging and failing dispatch radio console system was presented at the Fiscal Year 2018-19 budget workshop and included in the FY2018-19 budget as a Capital Improvement Program Project for approximately \$90,000. The funds were encumbered in Equipment Replacement fund 15-4970-4821.
