

RESOLUTION 2019 - 032

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA,
COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2017-
054 AND ADOPTING A RESOLUTION REVERTING 18 PARKING SPACES ON
THE SOUTH SIDE OF GERARD STREET TO UNRESTRICTED PARKING
PURSUANT TO SECTION 10.36.080 OF THE CALISTOGA MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2017 the City Council adopted Resolution 2017-054 which restricted parking on a portion of Gerard Street to three hours between the hours of 8 AM and 6 PM seven days a week for the duration of the Lincoln Avenue Bridge Project; and

WHEREAS, Cal Trans has recently completed construction of the Lincoln Avenue Bridge and the temporary closure of several parking spaces behind the Fire Department is no longer necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to revert 18 spaces on the south side of Gerard to unrestricted parking to provide additional long-term parking for visitors, residents and downtown employees, and is consistent with current parking restrictions in the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, the recommended action is general policy and procedure and is not a Project under CEQA pursuant to Section 15378(b) (4) of CEQA.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council rescinds Resolution 2017-054 and adopts this Resolution reverting 18 spaces on the south side of Gerard Street to unrestricted parking as shown on Exhibit A and directs the Public Works Department to remove the restricted hours parking signs as necessary.
