

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-029

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, PROCLAIMING THE TERMINATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE TO THE TUBBS FIRE AS PROCLAIMED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON OCTOBER 17, 2017, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 8550, ET SEQ

WHEREAS, a local emergency existed in the City of Calistoga, in accordance with the proclamation issued by the director of Emergency Services for the City of Calistoga on October 9, 2017, ratified by Resolution No. 2017-112, of the City Council on October 17, 2017, as a result of conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and/or property caused by the Tubbs Fire incident; and,

WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril are now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of and within the City of Calistoga.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby proclaim the termination of said local emergency.
