

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-081

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA SUPPORTING THE TWO RESOLUTIONS TO BE VOTED ON AT THE 2018 ANNUAL LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES CONFERENCE

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2018, the Council designated Mayor Canning as the voting delegate and Irais Lopez-Ortega as the alternate voting delegate to the League of California Cities Annual Meeting in Long Beach on September 14, 2018.

WHEREAS, the League of California Cities encourages each City Councilmember to consider two (2) Resolutions (Exhibit A) and to determine the City's position so the voting delegate can represent the City's position on the following proposed Resolution:

1. Resolution to explore a ballot measure relating to voter opportunity to strengthen local authority and preserve the role of local democracy to preserve local quality of life.
2. Resolution to support the repeal of preemption in California Food and Agriculture Code § 11501.1, preventing local governments from regulating pesticides.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Calistoga understands that policy development is a vital and ongoing process within the League of California Cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Calistoga has determined to support the two (2) League of California Cities proposed Resolutions to be voted on at the League General Assembly to be held on September 14, 2018 and authorizes Mayor Canning to vote in favor of the Resolutions.
