RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, TERMINATING THE DECLARATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY CAUSED BY FAILURE OF THE DUNAWEAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT WET PIT EFFLUENT PUMPS

WHEREAS, a period of local emergency previously existed in the City of Calistoga in accordance with the declaration thereof by the City Council on September 2, 2014 as a result of the conditions of extreme peril at the Dunaweal Wastewater Treatment Plant and without immediate corrective action the threat of serious harm to life, health and property existed; and

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2015 the City Council of the City of Calistoga received the report from the City's Public Works Director that the failed effluent pumps have been replaced and restored to service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Calistoga accepts the report from the Public Works Director and finds that the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril has been abated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Calistoga, State of California, hereby proclaims the termination of the local emergency associated with the failed effluent pumps effective January 20, 2015.
