F. CONSENT CALENDAR 17

1. Minutes Approval: Draft minutes for the August 14, 2019 meeting The consent calendar was adopted as presented.

G. PUBLIC HEARINGS

- 1. Sam's General Store at Brannan Cottage Inn Use Permit UP 2019-13: Consideration of a use permit application for wine and beer sales, and a walkaway food business at an existing inn at 109 Wappo Avenue
- Senior Planner Tusinger presented the staff report and recommended approval 24 of the use permit application, subject to conditions. 25
- Chair Coates opened the public hearing. 26
 - Carl Dene, applicant, gets a lot of requests from guests for a bottle of champagne or wine as part of their stay, but can't fulfill them. He would also like to encourage non-guests to visit the property and enjoy it by offering grab-and-go food items.
- In response to a question from Commissioner McNair, Mr. Dene explained that 31 all of the food to be sold would be prepared off-site. 32

In response to a question from **Commissioner Abernathy**, Mr. Dene advised that wine would not be offered for sale by the glass, but that they would like the ability to pour a glass for guests checking in.

Chair Coates closed the public hearing.

Commissioner Abernathy fully supports the proposed use permit because it would help the business and not be a wine tasting operation.

Commissioner Cooper is grateful for the preservation of the historic inn, and supports the proposed food and beverage operations.

A motion by **Commissioner Abernathy** to adopt the resolution approving UP 2019-13 was seconded by **Commissioner Cooper** and approved unanimously.

2. Joe Branum Tree Care - Use Permit application UP 2019-12 and Design Review application DR 2019-7: Consideration of use permit and design review applications for a tree care business with related storage of equipment and vehicles, and construction of a 600-square foot structure at 507 Washington St.

Chair Coates advised that he had a conflict of interest with this item due to the proximity of his residence and business to the project site, and left the dais.

- Vice Chair Wilkes assumed the chair.
- Senior Planner Tusinger presented the staff report.
- Vice Chair Wilkes opened the public hearing.
- Joe Branum, applicant, has had a business in Calistoga since 1991, which he wants to keep here. This proposal will give him that opportunity. He intends to preserve all the trees on the property.
- Vice Chair Wilkes closed the public hearing.
- Commissioner Cooper is very glad to see that the applicant has navigated through the entitlement process and believes that the project's design will fit in well with the neighborhood.
- **Vice Chair Wilkes** recognizes that the applicant has been looking for a suitable site for a long time, and appreciates the proposed building's porch feature.
- A motion by **Commissioner Cooper** to adopt the resolution approving UP 2019-12 and Design Review application DR 2019-7 was seconded by **Commissioner McNair** and approved unanimously.
- **Chair Coates** rejoined the meeting.

H. MATTERS INITIATED BY COMMISSIONERS

Vice Chair Wilkes should add tree keeping services to the allowed use list. Ms. Goldberg reminded the amendment that allowed them in the RR District.
