# MEETING NOTES Monday, February 2, 2009 – 3:30 P.M. Calistoga City Hall

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 p.m.

Members present included, Community Resources Commissioner Sue Harper, Calistoga Pool Project Committee member, Kerry Eddy, City Manager Jim McCann and Recreation Superintendent Frank DiFede. Absent: Community Resources Commissioner, Indira Lopez, Calistoga Pool Project Committee member, Sarah Gansa.

There were no public comments.

Previous notes from the January 12, 2009, were adopted as drafted.

### Update on Aquatic & Recreation Manager Recruitment

City Manager McCann provided an overview of the recruitment effort, noting that almost three dozen applications had been received and that those applications had been reviewed and a candidate pool of approximately six individuals was selected for further consideration. An interview panel interviewed the six and selected the three top candidates. One candidate is clearly most suitable for our particular needs and we expect to have her start with us later this month.

### Update on Pool Construction Activity

City Manager McCann provided an update on the construction activities at the pool and summarized the outstanding work yet to be completed.

## <u>Update on Pool Programs and Staffing Update</u>

Recreation Superintendent DiFede provided an overview of the recruitment efforts and training activity occurring to date. He noted that nearly a dozen Calistoga teenagers are involved in conditioning and training for the lifeguard certification program and that approximately two dozen individuals overall have expressed interest in lifeguarding, water safety instruction and other programming activities at the pool. There was much discussion regarding additional recruitment efforts, including outreach to adults and seniors who may be interested in part-time employment at the pool.

There was general discussion about anticipated pool programming with the agreement that much effort must be applied to discussing and refining initial programming ideas upon the arrival of the Aquatics & Recreation Manager this month. It was agreed that the item would be placed on the next agenda in the hope that the Aquatics & Recreation Manager will be present to participate in the discussion. City Manager McCann reminded the group that the settlement agreement with the neighborhood group requires that they be included in a discussion regarding anticipated programming and that their input be considered in programming decisions. It was agreed that once initial programming ideas are developed that outreach to the neighborhood group should occur to solicit their input.

#### **Pool Plaques**

Kerry Eddy discussed thoughts regarding the plaques to be installed at the pool and noted that the commemorative plaque to be installed by the CCPP will "tell the story" and that the City's plaque will likely be more concise, acknowledging the City and CCPP partnership. It was agreed that City Manager McCann would prepare a few alternate drafts of the City plaque language for Committee input.

#### Geothermal Feasibility Study

The Committee briefly discussed elements of the Geothermal Feasibility Study and noted the strong interest in pursuing available grant and other funding opportunities to install the geothermal heating system. City Manager McCann indicated that it is the City's intent to pursue such public and private funding opportunities. Kerry Eddy indicated that the CCPP also hopes to pursue and secure funding opportunities, principally through private funding sources. It was agreed that this should be a priority for the pool project.

The Committee set their next meeting for Monday, February 23, 2009, 2:30 p.m., Calistoga City Hall.
