DESCRIPTION:

This is an informational item providing the City Council an opportunity to review the draft Calistoga Community Survey.

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive report and provide feedback to staff regarding proposed survey questions.

BACKGROUND:

At its October 1, 2019 meeting, the Council suggested several changes to the draft survey and directed staff to bring the survey back for final review.

ANALYSIS:

During the goal setting and budgeting process earlier this calendar year, the City Council directed staff to develop a community survey for the purpose of gathering information and feedback from residents.

Community surveys are increasingly used by cities to solicit feedback from residents on a wide variety of topics including community perception, community priorities or concerns, and staff performance. The information generated by these types of surveys is useful in setting goals, developing future budgets, planning capital projects, and identifying improvements to city programs. Surveys such as this should be conducted periodically, either annually or every other year, so that results to certain questions can be compared to see trends over time.

Concerns expressed by residents through the survey can be addressed, and new concerns can be noted for possible future action by the city. As new issues arise or are

identified, additional questions can be added to (or removed from) the survey each time it is distributed.

As drafted the survey features a variety of questions related to quality of life issues and community perceptions, infrastructure, downtown, and recreation services. There are also optional demographics questions to help measure response rates from different demographics. It is important to note that the survey is completely anonymous.

Based on feedback received from the City Council at its October 1, 2019 meeting, staff has made several edits to the draft survey which include eliminating or rewording several questions, and adding survey questions pertaining to Nixle Alerts and climate change. The multiple-choice answers for several questions were also altered or simplified based on Council suggestions.

The quality of the data generated by community surveys such as this one relies heavily on a good response rate across all the city's demographics. With that in mind, the survey will be conducted primarily online in English and in Spanish with a paper option available as well. Staff will alert residents to the availability of the survey through postcards sent through the mail, links on the city's website, eNotify, the newspaper, social media, flyers, and outreach to various community groups.

If the Council approves the amended survey questions (Attachment 1), the survey would go live in mid to late October and be open through mid-November. This should maximize the opportunity for responses before the holidays, but also give staff adequate time to analyze the data before the end of the calendar year. Staff will share the survey results with the City Council and the community via a report and presentation at a future City Council meeting.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The survey will be conducted for less than \$2,000 using budgeted funds from Account Number 01-4114-4415, where sufficient appropriations for the purposes of this survey were put in the FY 19-20 budget. Funds will be spent on online survey software, printing, and mailing.
