MEETING NOTES Monday, February 23, 2009 – 2:30 P.M. Calistoga City Hall

The meeting was called to order at 2:30 p.m.

Members present included, Calistoga Pool Project Committee members, Kerry Eddy and Sarah Gansa, City Manager Jim McCann, Aquatics & Recreation Manager, Olivia Lemen and Recreation Superintendant, Frank DiFede. Absent: Community Resources Commissioners, Indira Lopez and Sue Harper.

There were no public comments.

Introduction of Olivia Lemen, Aquatics & Recreation Manager

City Manager McCann introduced Olivia Lemen and she provided a review of her background, interest in Calistoga and thoughts for the Community Pool.

February 2, 2009, were adopted as drafted.

Community Pool construction progress

City Manager McCann provided an update on the construction activities at the pool and summarized the outstanding work yet to be completed.

Pool Programs and Outreach Ideas

City Manager McCann outlined his thoughts and progress to date and stated the need for discussion to define scope and the need to recognize the obligation to the Calistoga School District and to meet with and receive input from the Concerned Citizens of Calistoga Group. The consensus of the Committee was to reach out to the Concerned Citizens Group to bring them up to speed on initial thinking regarding programming, to introduce ideas, share plans and include them in future meetings. It was also decided that Olivia should meet with Robert Bragg as soon as possible to begin this process.

Olivia presented preliminary programming and conceptual ideas for the spring and summer schedules.

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Sara Gansa reiterated the need for a focus on training and hiring bilingual 37 38 lifeguards and also the importance of serving the senior population. She urged 39 staff to speak with Kevin Twohey regarding the St. Helena Masters swim 40 program and discuss the likelihood of the St. Helena pool closure this season. 41 42 There was discussion regarding preliminary facility guidelines and appropriate 43 attire for pool staff. The Committee agreed that the first year programs should 44 be kept focused and simple and allow them to grow over time. 45 46 Staff Recruitment and Training 47 48 Recreation Superintendant Frank DiFede reported that the first lifeguard class has 49 concluded and that six Calistoga teens passed and are now certified lifequards. 50 51 Opening Statement for Summer Activity Guide 52 53 There was discussion about creating a letter to the community outlining the pool 54 opening and programming for the Activity Guide. 55 56 Plaque Language 57 58 City Manager McCann stated that the wording is in progress and the committee 59 reviewed the draft wording.
