<u>COVID-19 Reopening Guidance for Tasting Rooms with Secondary Retail</u> <u>now that Retail is permitted</u>

Many tasting rooms in Calistoga have secondary retail in addition to operating as a wine tasting room. Napa County has been approved for restaurants and *retail business* to reopen subject to certain limitations and requirements including physical distancing, sanitation procedures and wearing gloves and face coverings.

As such, the City Calistoga is advising that those tasting rooms which have secondary retail activities component are now allowed to open as a <u>retail</u> business establishment subject to the following:

- Must post signage at the entryway to the business that indicate no tastings are available, remove tasting menus, and post signage on tasting bar, counter, and service areas that tastings are not permitted.
- You may sell wine by the bottle or the case unopened.
- To reopen your retail business you are required by the State of California and the County of Napa to do a number of things including a risk assessment, employee training, implement individual control measures, implement disinfecting protocols, and implement physical distancing protocols, and require employees and patrols to use face coverings.
