September 9, 2020 at 5:30 p.m.

Chair Coates called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. He read a special message concerning the conduct of the virtual meeting in accordance with provisions related to COVID-19.

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11 D. ADOPTION OF MEETING AGENDA

The meeting agenda was adopted as presented.

E. COMMUNICATIONS/CORRESPONDENCE

Director Tusinger indicates that a large number of Calistogans did not have power for the last 48 hours or so due to the planned power outage (PSPS). He says that based on input by the city attorney and staff, the recommended action is to continue the hearings to a date certain to give all residents the opportunity to participate. There has been no correspondence related to the current public hearing on the amended agenda after it was recommended for a continuance to a later date. However, he explained there is correspondence on the public hearing topics and expects to receive more between now and the next meeting date, which will be distributed to commissioners and made available to the public.

F. CONSENT CALENDAR

 Minutes Approval: Draft minutes for the August 26, 2020 meeting The Consent Calendar was adopted as presented.

G. PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. 1448 North Oak Townhomes - DR 2020-6, TM 2020-1 Consideration of a continuance to a date certain (September 23, 2020) of a design review and tentative map applications to allow for demolition of two residential structures and a tank house, and replace with six residential units in the form of two, two-story townhome triplex buildings with an accompanying condominium map. This proposed action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15332 of the CEQA Guidelines.

Recommended Action: Continue the item to the September 23, 2020 Planning Commission meeting

Director Tusinger made a brief statement about the item and the need for a continuance. He notes that due to the PSPS, it is recommended the meeting be continued to a later date. He reminds the public that any comments on the matter be related to the continuance of the hearing and not to the substance of the project.

The applicant, **Ralph Strauss** says he is understanding of the circumstances behind the continuance and is excited to move the project forward and discuss it in two weeks.

Commissioners do not have any comments regarding the continuance.

A motion by **Vice Chair Wilkes** to continue item G-1 to the September 23 Planning Commission meeting is seconded by **Chair Coates** and approved unanimously.

2. The Veranda Hotel at Indian Springs DR 2017-8, UP 2017-9, DA 2017-1 Consideration of a continuance to a date certain (September 23, 2020) of a design review, use permit, and development agreement to allow for demolition of seven existing single-story structures onsite and for the development a 96-room hotel, restaurant, ground floor retail, pools and spas heated through a closed loop system with geothermal water, public courtyard, parking and streetscape improvements to Lincoln Avenue and Fair Way as well as an Emergency Vehicle Access road extending between Fair Way Extension and Magnolia Drive. An Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared for this project in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act.

Recommended Action: Continue the item to the September 23, 2020 Planning Commission meeting

Chair Coates recuses himself due to a conflict of interest and leaves the meeting.

Director Tusinger provides a brief update regarding the item and notes that there is a lot of material for the public to view and for commissioners to review. He says that in light of the PSPS, staff recommends moving the item to a later date to provide enough time for all to review.

Commissioners do not have any comments regarding the continuance.

A motion by **Commissioner Allan** to continue item G-2 to the September 23 Planning Commission meeting is seconded by **Commissioner McNair** and approved unanimously (**Chair Coates** absent).
