WHEREAS, the Planning and Building Department received an application from 2 Robert Sanders & Company requesting a sign permit approval to allow for two new 3 signs associated with a winery at 333 Silverado Trail; and 4 WHEREAS, according to CMC 17.58.060.B(8) signs located in a Planned 5 Development District require permission of the Planning Commission; and 6 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission considered the request at its regular 7 meeting on April 28, 2021. EXHIBIT A

Conditions of Approval

- 1. The improvements and designs hereby permitted shall substantially conform to the plans received as part of the subject application by the Planning and Building Department, except as noted in these permit conditions.
- Lighting for the hanging sign is approved as shown in the submitted plans, provided the lighting is timed to shut off at 9 p.m., and not come on again until the following evening.
- Minor modifications to the project design that do not generate environmental impacts may be approved in writing by the Planning and Building Director.
- This approval shall be null and void if not used within a year, unless an extension has been issued for the project prior to the expiration date.
- 5. Staff shall perform a final inspection of all installed signage, lighting, and landscaping to verify compliance.
