

Napa Valley Brewing Company & Calistoga Inn


The Napa Valley Brewing Company was established in 1987 and nests in the original water tower of the Calistoga Inn. It was founded as the first brewery in Napa County since the end of prohibition and was a pioneer in the evolution of the craft brewing industry.


The purpose of the proposed expansion is to increase the fermentation and brite tank storage capacity. This additional capacity will allow NVBC to offer its guests that patronize the Calistoga Inn restaurant up to 9-10 different beer styles throughout the season. Due to the limiting existing capacity, it's a challenge to keep up with demand.


Additionally, the "beer garden" is a popular event space. Showcasing the beer tanks through large windows as part of the beer garden experience will be an added attraction.


