Proposed updates to City's Administrative Policy.

City Policies

- 1. City staff shall work with the Green Committee and community to establish a public education campaign regarding the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance, including notice to Food Providers of its provisions, means of compliance, and penalties for noncompliance, prior to its effective date.
- 2. The City may add and/or remove standards for Compostable products through an amendment to the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance.
- 3. Regulations issued by the City Manager may in the future add or exclude specific products or product types considered compostable for purposes of the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance should the commercial capability by City contracted collection program vendor(s) change and/or new technologies allow for the inclusion of additional products or product types as Compostable.
- 4. The City shall maintain on its website a list of suppliers that offer Foodware that complies with the standards set forth in the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance, which shall be updated as needed, or at least yearly.
- 5. The City shall not have drinking water systems (i.e., vending machines) in City offices and facilities that use Plastic Bottled beverages of any size where sufficient alternatives exist and are feasible. City offices and facilities shall conform drinking water systems where reasonable.

City's Purchasing Policies

- 1. The City's purchasing policies shall be amended for consistency with the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance.
- The City shall not purchase any Disposable Foodware that does not comply with the Disposable Foodware standards set forth in the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance, nor shall any City-sponsored event utilize noncompliant Foodware.
- The City shall not purchase or acquire Polystyrene Foodware, containers, coolers, or ice chests except as allowed elsewhere in the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance, for use at City Facilities, for City events, or otherwise in the conduct of City business.
- 4. The City shall not purchase Plastic Bottled beverages except as exempted or allowed in the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance.
- 5. The City shall not sponsor or co-sponsor events at which Polystyrene Foodware or products are used or distributed by Event Promoters, Food Providers, and/or any other party, including nonprofit organizations. The City's monetary contribution to such an event shall be refunded to the City if the City Manager determines that Polystyrene Foodware was used at the event in violation of the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance. Compliance shall be mandated via Special Event Agreements as authorized by CMC Chapter 5.18 Special Events.

City Facilities

- All rental agreements to use City facilities shall require contracting parties to prevent the use or distribution of Polystyrene Foodware and products at the City facility. The agreement shall provide that the contractor's security deposit will be forfeited if the City Manager determines that Polystyrene Foodware or products were utilized in violation of the rental agreement.
- 2. The City shall not enter into any new leases, contracts, or other forms of agreement, or issue any new permits, bid proposals, or solicitations; or renew, amend, or reissue any existing leases, contracts, agreements, or permits, which allow City property to be used for the sale or distribution of Plastic Bottled beverages.
- 3. All individuals, entities, or organizations using City facilities for public or private events shall comply with the requirements, terms, and conditions set forth in the Reusable Foodware and Waste Reduction Ordinance.
