Public Works Director Takasugi provided an overview of the Geothermal Feasibility Study that was completed on December 19, 2008, and discussed the costs and terms of payback for geothermal and solar heating.

City Manager McCann discussed the costs versus savings opportunities regarding geothermal use. He also noted that there is potential for energy efficiency grants through ARRA which might be available in the next 60 days.

There was consensus from the Committee that staff pursue these options in an attempt to off-set utility costs and address green initiatives.

#### Calistoga Community Pool Project Committee plaques

Kerry Eddy presented a draft of the proposed CCPP Plaque; all found it to be attractive and acceptable.

#### **Concession options**

There was discussion about options for a portable concession stand and discussion regarding the regulations required by the Napa County Health Department and noted that space is very limited.

The Committee's consensus was to pursue a portable stand with simple/limited scope of healthy food products.

#### **Lighting Outcomes**

Staff provided a summary of the field meeting with the neighbors to view the lights.

Staff provided an overview of the Council's discussion and action regarding the committee's recommended action.

Kerry Eddy commented that the pool is looking great but does not feel the fence is tall enough and believes it should be at least 8" tall to keep people out after hours. She also noted that the grass looks great and asked about maintenance of the grass.
