 Green/Sustainable Practices: On-Going. Working with City staff and the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency, a draft of the Climate Action Plan was completed. CRC sub-committee worked at great length to ensure that realistic and obtainable goals for Calistoga were incorporated in each element of the plan. It went before a joint meeting of the CRC and the Planning Commission early August for public comment and has been recommended for approval to the City Council.

 Senior Services: Received presentation and overview of amended Rent Stabilization Ordinance. As needed or requested staff will provide update.

 Aquatic Programs: On-Going. Though a sub-committee of the CRC, the Calistoga Pool Advisory Committee, review and recommendations were made on the Calistoga Community Pool. The CRC will continue to advise City staff on the pool opportunities.

 Activity Guide: On April 15th, 2009, the CRC reviewed and discussed the future of the Activity Guide and improvements in its content and method of delivery.

28 29 Recreation Facilities at Logvy Park: Commissioner More sat on the planning sub-committee for this project and provided input in master plan and facility needs. Final Park Master Plan going to CRC for review and public comment in August and then to Planning Commission and City Council for approval.

The CRC has continued to express their interest in maintaining a very focused work plan to ensure their effectiveness on tasks.

BACKGROUND: Within the adopted 2009/2010 Goals and Objectives of the City of Calistoga, emphasis has been place on creating an environmentally sustainable community and expanding and improving recreational services. • City Recreation Programming and Educational Opportunities: Assist in a comprehensive review of the City's recreation services and programs and offer recommendation for improvement.
