A RESOLUTION FORWARDING A RECOMMENDATION TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE APPROVAL OF REVISIONS TO THE MASTER PLAN FOR LOGVY COMMUNITY PARK LOCATED AT 1745 WASHINGTON STREET (APNs 011-410-009 and 011-140-056) WITHIN THE PUBLIC / QUASI-PUBLIC ZONING DISTRICT.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Calistoga owns the 10 +/- acres known as the Logvy Park property ("Property"), APNs 011-410-009 and 011-014-056; and

WHEREAS, and Initial Study was prepared for the Logvy Community Park Master Plan ("Master Plan") in April, 1999 and a Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring Program were adopted (Resolution 99-27) on May 18, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calistoga previously adopted the Master Plan (Resolution 99-30) on May 18, 1999 to guide the development of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council noted that the Master Plan would require amendment in the future as new opportunities and community desires arise; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Calistoga has completed improvements to the Property for public park purposes, including baseball and soccer fields, a community swimming pool, and other site improvements; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, as part of the update process to the Master Plan to pursue the Community Pool element, the City adopted and Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration adopted in 1999 (Resolution 2004-089), which reflected a change in the site plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Noise Mitigation Measure XI.A of the 2004 Addendum to the Mitigated Negative Declaration, the City of Calistoga hired an expert acoustical consultant to prepare a noise study to examine potential noise impacts and project alternatives related to the planned construction of the Community Pool; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on November 8, 2006 authorized preparation of a reconfigured site plan for construction of the Community Pool based on results of the preliminary noise study (Resolution 2006-102); and

WHEREAS, a reconfigured site plan for the Community Pool was developed by the City with input form the Community Pool Advisory Committee, which places the swimming pools at the northwest corner of the Property and parking areas by the southwest corner; and

WHEREAS, the final noise study evaluated noise impacts related to the reconfigured site plan for the Community Pool project, which includes use of a sound wall alongside a limited portion of the south and southwest sides of the pool area, and determined that the reconfigured site plan would reduce any potential noise impacts to less than significant levels; and

**WHEREAS,** on March 6, 2007, the City Council adopted a Second Addendum to the Mitigation Negative Declaration adopted in 1999 (Resolution 2007-020), which reflected the changed location of the Community Pool and parking areas; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 1, 2007, an advisory committee made up of elected and appointed officials, city staff, a community representative and the project consultant was formed to discuss the key recreation elements of the Logvy Park Master Plan update and provide preliminary guidance and direction on the revised plan; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2007, a stakeholder meeting was conducted to review draft versions of the updated Logvy Park Master Plan and receive input; and

**WHEREAS,** on January 10, 2008, a public meeting was held, attended by approximately 30 members of the community and City staff, where there was strong praise for the planning process and support for the revisions and refinements to the Park Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the revisions that were presented to and supported by the community have been incorporated into a revised Master Plan for improvement of Logvy Community Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission considered the proposed revisions to the Logvy Community Park Master Plan at its regular meeting on September 9, 2009, and prior to taking action on the proposed revisions, received written and oral reports by the staff, and received public testimony; and

**WHEREAS**, the potential environmental impacts of the revised Master Plan, including noise impacts and impacts to archaeological resources, were evaluated in an Initial Study that was prepared pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and

**WHEREAS,** it was determined that, with mitigation measures, the revisions to the Master Plan would not have a significant impact on the environment and the Planning Commission has recommended to the City Council that a Mitigated Negative Declaration be adopted;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Calistoga Planning Commission that, based on the above findings, the proposed revisions to the Logvy Community Park Master Plan are forwarded to the City Council with a recommendation for approval.
