SUBJECT: UNREASONABLE HARDSHIP REQUEST AT 1323 CEDAR

STREET - JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES

ISSUE:

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A request has been received for an unreasonable hardship for the existing entrance at 1323 Cedar Street.

BACKGROUND:

Current ADA law requires interior or exterior rooms, spaces, or elements that are made available to the public be provided with an accessible entrance at a building or facility that is privately or publicly owned.

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The 2007 California Building Code (CBC) Section 1134B requires all entrances and exterior ground floor exit doors to buildings and facilities be made accessible to persons with disabilities.

The Calistoga Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses were issued a building permit no. 5075 to repair and remodel the existing church and apartments. The permit was conditioned so that access to the building is provided or an unreasonable hardship claim be submitted for action ratified by the Building Standards Advisory and Appeals Board (BSAAB).

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the unreasonable hardship based on the current design and location of the entrance and the disproportional cost of the project as outlined within the unreasonable form.
