SUBJECT:

Agricultural Lease with Markham Vineyards

1 ISSUE: Consideration of a Resolution approving an Amended Agricultural Lease with Markham

- 2 Vineyards and directing the City Manager to execute the amended Lease Agreement.
- 3 **RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution.
- 4 **DISCUSSION**: The City acquired land as a part of the Kimball Reservoir construction in 1940's.
- 5 Starting in 1973 the City entered into an Agricultural Lease Agreement with Markham Vineyards
- for approximately 6.23 acres for the purpose of producing wine grapes. In 1999 the City Council
- wished to revisit the terms of the 1973 Agreement resulting in the City Council approving the
- 8 May 5, 1999 Agricultural Lease Agreement with rent tied into the current market lease rates
- 9 based on the Annual Grape Crush Crop Report for the Napa Valley. The 1999 Agreement
- 10 provided for a two one-year lease extension option. Markham Vineyards exercised the
- extension option in 1999 but failed to provide the requisite notice in 2000 therefore the
- 12 Agreement expired on December 31, 2000.
- On May 9, 2001 the City entered into a new Agricultural Lease Agreement with Markham
- 14 Vineyards. Since then the City has renewed this Agreement on an annual basis pursuant to the
- terms of the agreement. Section 16 "Water" of the 2001 Agreement states that the City may
- provide City water to irrigate the grapevines on the leased property, however, Markham
- 17 Vineyards has never requested that the City provide water delivery pursuant to the 2001
- Agreement, and they are not an established water customer. Further this provision conflicts with
- 19 elements of our water license from the State. It has been brought to staff's attention that the
- water provision in the 2001 Agreement is not useful, and should be deleted. The proposed
- 20 2010 Amended Agreement, attached, clearly states that City water will not be provided to the
- 22 property for any purpose; all other provisions remain in place.
- 23 Markham Vineyards has been a good tenant, and staff recommends the approval of the
- 24 attached Amendment with the provision of continuing a year-to-year lease option with Markham
- 25 Vineyards.
