Authorization to Purchase of a Replacement Vehicle for Police

Department

APPROVAL FOR FORWARDING:

**ISSUE:** Adoption of a Resolution to authorize the expenditure of budgeted funds to purchase a replacement patrol car for the Police Department from Downtown Ford of Sacramento in the amount of \$29,194.78.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the Resolution authorizing the purchase of a replacement vehicle and related equipment for the vehicle.

**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** The City Council has budgeted funds for the purchase of a replacement Police Department patrol vehicle in the amount of \$33,000. This amount was estimated to be the cost of purchasing and equipping a new police package vehicle.

This purchase will replace an existing patrol vehicle from the department fleet, based on a five-year replacement cycle for marked patrol cars. The vehicle being replaced is a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria. Upon being replaced It will be declared surplus and sold to an automobile auction.

Because our department has the same specifications for patrol vehicles as the California Highway Patrol, it has been our practice to purchase replacement vehicles through the automobile dealer (contract vendor) who has already been awarded the State contract for CHP specification patrol cars. By doing this, we can "piggy back" off the CHP contract and are able to purchase a vehicle at the lowest possible price. Downtown Ford Sales of Sacramento is the State contract vendor for the 2008

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model year Ford Crown Victoria CHP specification police vehicles. The purchase price of the patrol vehicle includes certain dealer-installed equipment that renders the vehicle usable as a police vehicle.

Currently there are no alternative fuel or hybrid vehicles that meet the performance specifications of the State contract.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** \$33,000 was budgeted in the Equipment Replacement Fund for replacement of one patrol car. The purchase price and partial outfitting of the new police vehicle (\$29,194.78) is below the budgeted amount by \$3,805.22. Some of the equipment necessary to complete the outfitting of the new vehicle will be reused from the patrol unit being replaced. The purchase of new light bar, vehicle graphics and other necessary emergency response equipment for the vehicle will be made with the remaining funds.

Funds generated from the sale of the replaced vehicle will be returned to the City.
