The Public Works Department has received a request from Braden Sterk, a member of Calistoga Boy Scout Troop No. 18, to be allowed permission to construct a composting facility near the Community Garden at Logvy Community Park. The proposed composting facility is to be located as close as possible to the Community Garden, so that organic waste materials can be hauled from the garden, and processed compost can be hauled back into the garden in a very sustainable manner.

Several months ago, the Garden Club had solicited the Public Works Department on their desire to construct a compost bin near the community garden. This request

Braden Sterk wishes to manage and complete this project as his Eagle Scout project. Staff believes that this is a good and worthwhile project and recommends that City Council accept Braden Sterk's offer of a donation of the composting facility project and also recommends that all permit fees be waived.


Value received by City due to this improvement at Logvy Community Park (unquantified) is expected to more than offset the waived permit fees.
