<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The California Government Code and the Calistoga Municipal Code allow the City Council to establish compensation levels for Councilmembers and members of the Planning Commission. The City Council has received compensation of \$200 per month since June of 1996 and the Planning Commission has received a stipend of \$50 per meeting since August of 2008.

During the December 1, 2009 budget update discussion, Councilmember Kraus suggested that these stipends should be reduced by 10% as a leadership gesture given the economically challenging times. Councilmember Kraus has requested that the item be discussed for possible action.

FISCAL IMPACT: The fiscal impact will vary depending upon the action taken by Council. Presently, the City budgets approximately \$18,000 annually for Commissioner and Councilmember compensation.
