SUBJECT:

Napa Countywide Community Climate Action Framework

ISSUE: Consider forwarding a recommendation to the City Council expressing the Community Resources Commission's support of the Napa Countywide Community Climate Action Framework and directing the Napa County Transportation & Planning Agency (NCTPA) Board of Directors to adopt the Framework.

RECOMMENDATION: Receive report and provide recommendation.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The City has historically been a leader in environmental stewardship and has taken an active role in promoting conservation through public policy decisions since the early 1990s. In 2003 the City adopted a General Plan that embodies and embraces the City's continued attention to environmental sustainability. In 2004 the City Council furthered its efforts by establishing the Community Resources Commission (CRC) whom advices the City Council on broad range of community interest matters, including environmental initiatives.

On August 5, 2009 the CRC held a special joint meeting with the Planning Commission, wherein they solicited comments and discussed the Preliminary Draft Napa Countywide Climate Action Plan and supplemental Climate Action Plan (CAP) Framework that was being drafted in cooperation with Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA). Subsequently, on August 18, 2009 the City Council considered the recommendation of the Community Resources Commission to support the preliminary actions described within the Preliminary Draft Countywide Climate Action Plan Framework. The Council supported the Preliminary Draft and directed the CRC to work with Staff to finalize and begin implementing the Draft Plan.

Over the past several months the Green Subcommittee, the CRC and Staff have been actively pursuing the completion of the Climate Action Plan through the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA). Through this effort the Climate Action Plan has taken somewhat of a different approach. At an NCTPA Technical Advisory

Committee (TAC) meeting in November of last year, the NCTPA TAC suggested, as a result of amended California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines, that the document should be recast as a broad policy "framework", with a comprehensive description of the issues involved and that the detailed actions proposed by each iurisdiction be included in a subsequent set of formal planning documents or local Subsequently on December 16, 2009, the NCTPA Board Climate Action Plan. considered this course of action and supported the framework and released the document for public review. As such, this Framework is being brought back to the CRC for their consideration and support. Should the CRC continue to support these efforts, Staff recommends that the CRC forward a recommendation to the City Council to direct the NCTPA Board to adopt the Napa Countywide Community Climate Action Framework.
