ISSUE:

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Consideration of a Resolution directing the City Engineer to prepare and file a report for the Silverado Place Subdivision Landscape Maintenance District in accordance with Article 4 of Chapter 1 of the Streets and Highways Code.

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RECOMMENDATION:

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Adopt Resolution.

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BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

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Through the conditions of approval for the Silverado Place Subdivision, the City required the establishment of a Landscape Maintenance District (assessment district) to fund the maintenance of adjacent public landscaping through the levying of assessments on the parcels within that subdivision.

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The Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (Streets and Highways Code 22500-22647) requires that the City undertake certain proceedings for any fiscal year during which an assessment is proposed to be levied and collected. These proceedings are usually accomplished at three separate Council meetings and include the following Council actions:

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1) Adopt a resolution directing the City Engineer to prepare and file a report.

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25	2)	Approve the Engineer's Report, declare the City Council's intent to levy
26		and collect assessments and set the date for a public hearing.

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3) Conduct a public hearing and authorize the actual levying and collection of assessments.

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The Resolution for this meeting continues the process for the 2010/2011 assessment. At the June 1st meeting you will receive the Engineer's Report and the date for a public hearing will be set. At the third meeting a Public Hearing will be held to consider the proposed assessment.

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FISCAL IMPACT:

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Fiscal impact will be determined after the preparation of the Engineer's Report.
