



*WHEREAS, every child in our great Napa County is a precious gift, full of promise and potential; and*

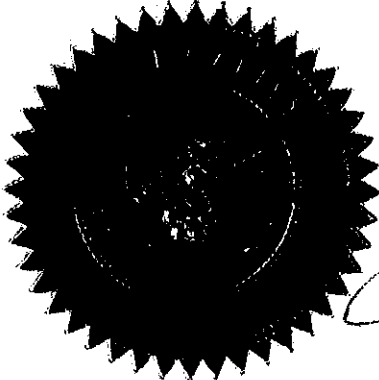
*WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect is a serious problem in California and across the nation; and*
