1 **ISSUE:** Consideration of a Resolution rescinding Resolution No. 2000-103 and authorizing the

- 2 appointment of the Administrative Services Director as the City's Director to the Public Agency
- 3 Risk Sharing Authority of California (PARSAC) Board of Directors and appointing the City Clerk as
- 4 an Alternate Director.
- 5 **RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution.
- 6 BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The City of Calistoga has been a member of PARSAC since
- 1986. PARSAC is a self-funded group of Cities who have joined together through a joint powers
- 8 authority for risk sharing and liability purposes. The by-laws of PARSAC require that each
- 9 community designate an alternate representative to the Board of Directors. In December 2000 the
- 10 Council adopted Resolution No. 2000-103 appointing the Administrative Services Director, to
- serve as its Alternate Director on the PARSAC Board of Directors.
- 12 Typically the Director has been the City Manager and the alternate has been the Administrative
- Services Director. With the resignation of the City Manager there is a need to appoint the
- Administrative Services Director as the Director with the City Clerk as the Alternate Director to
- 15 PARSAC. The City Clerk interacts directly with PARSAC staff with regard to liability issues,
- Workers Compensation matters, and typical claims against the City.
- Appointment of the City Clerk as the City's Alternate Director to the Board of Directors will allow in
- the Administrative Services Director's absence the City Clerk to attend and vote at regular
- 19 PARSAC meetings on matters which have bearing on our premiums and the policies which we
- 20 must follow.
