A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA APPROVING A MILLS ACT PROGRAM TO IMPLEMENT THE MILLS ACT (CALIFORNIA STATE GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 50280 ET SEQ.) IN THE CITY OF CALISTOGA AND DIRECTING PREPARATION OF A HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 50280 et seq. ("the Mills Act"), the City Council may establish a program providing for a historical property preservation agreement ("preservation agreement") with an owner of a historic property for the purpose of preservation, rehabilitation, and maintenance of a designated historic resource in accordance with the United States Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation, the State Historical Building Code, and applicable City codes ("Mills Act program"). The preservation agreement allows the owner to receive a reduction in property taxes in exchange for the property owner's commitment to specific repair, restoration, and/or rehabilitation improvements and satisfactory maintenance of the historic property; and

WHEREAS, the Community Identity Element of the City's General Plan calls for conservation of Calistoga's historic, architectural and cultural resources and sets forth policies promoting the use of proactive techniques to encourage owners to preserve and maintain their historic properties; and

WHEREAS, adoption of a Mills Act program will implement the directives of the Community Identity Element of the General Plan by providing a significant economic incentive for owners to participate in the rehabilitation, restoration, preservation and maintenance of their historic property; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission considered the proposed Mills Act program at a regular meeting held on August 25, 2010, and prior to taking action the Planning Commission received written and oral reports by the staff, and received public testimony. After considering the proposed program, the Planning Commission passed a Motion recommending establishment of a Mills Act program and preparation of a historic preservation ordinance to encourage preservation of historic properties within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the draft Mills Act program at its regular meeting on September 7, 2010, and prior to taking action on the program received written and oral reports by the staff and received public testimony; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that this action is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA Guidelines.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Calistoga that:

1. A Mills Act program is hereby established to implement the Mills Act in the City of Calistoga ("the Mills Act Program"). The Mills Act Program shall go into effect as of September 7, 2010 and shall continue in effect unless terminated or cancelled in accordance with the Mills Act.

2. To limit the fiscal impact of the Mills Act program on the City, the City shall not enter into or execute more than three (3) preservation agreements per calendar year. Applications for preservation agreements shall be processed on a first-come, first-served basis to the first three qualifying, completed applications received in a calendar year. If less than three

preservation agreements are recorded during a calendar year, the remainder may be rolled 55 56 over to the next calendar year.

The City Council hereby delegates to the Planning and Building Director of the City of Calistoga or his or her designee, with review by the City Attorney, the authority and responsibility to develop and maintain and application, administrative guidelines, and form of preservation agreement for properties seeking qualification and participation in the Mills Act program. The terms of the preservation agreement shall comply with Government Code Section 50280 et seq. The maintenance, repair, rehabilitation, and/or restoration standards applicable to the subject property shall be set forth in the preservation agreement. In consideration for abiding with the terms of the preservation agreement, the owner of the subject property shall be entitled to qualify for a reassessment of the historic property pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code Section 439 et seq.

The City Council shall be the final authority on the authorization and approval of preservation agreements pursuant to the Mills Act program.

No preservation agreement shall be cancelled without compliance with Government Code Section 50280 et seg., including proper notice and a public hearing.

A "qualified historic property" for the purposes of the City of Calistoga's Mills Act program shall be a residential or commercial property that is:

Located within city limits of the City of Calistoga; and (a)

(b) Privately owned; and

(c) Not exempt from property taxation; and

Listed in the National Register of Historic Places or located in a registered (d) historic district; OR

Listed in any state, city, county, or city and county official register of historical (e) or architecturally significant sites, places, or landmarks.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, based on the recommendation of the Planning Commission and General Plan goals and objectives calling for the preservation of the City's historic resources, the City Council of the City of Calistoga directs staff to prepare a historic preservation ordinance that would set forth the necessary procedures and criteria for establishing a local register of historic places.
