1 **ISSUE:** Consideration of a Resolution confirming the Mayor's recommendation for appointment to the newly created Napa County Local Foods Advisory Council.

- 3 **RECOMMENDATION**: Confirm recommendation and adopt Resolution.
- 4 **DISCUSSION**: The County of Napa has created a new advisory board to advise the
- 5 Agricultural Commissioner and Board of Supervisors on the development and promotion of a
- 6 sustainable local food system in Napa County. This newly created body will be made up of
- 7 representatives from the public and private sector, and will require representation from the
- 8 incorporated cities and town throughout the County of Napa.
- 9 The makeup of this commission will consist of one member of the Board of Supervisors, five
- representatives from incorporated cities (and town), three representatives from the field of
- agriculture, one individual from the public health or nutrition field, one individual representing
- "institutions", one individual in the field of marketing and/or distribution of agricultural products,
- and three representatives from the community at large. Terms are for four years.
- 14 The County wishes to move quickly and hopes to bring the matter before the Board of
- Supervisors to confirm appointments later this month, and set the first meeting of the newly
- created Local Food Advisory Council to January 15, 2011.
- An advertisement for these positions was placed on the City's website, and posted in the display
- cases around town. At the closing date for applications to be submitted, an application was
- received from Mr. Lynn Brown to represent the City.

Applicants Sought for Napa County Local Food Advisory Council Deadline Extended to Dec. 17

(NAPA, Calif.--) The County Executive Officer announces openings on the newly created Local Foods Advisory Council. The Napa County Local Food Advisory Council will advise the Agricultural Commissioner and Board of Supervisors regarding the development and promotion of a sustainable local food system and help set priorities, plan and implement initiatives to improve the environmental, economic and social sustainability of food production in Napa County.

The Napa County Local Food Advisory Council will be composed of fifteen (15) members, appointed by the County of Napa Board of Supervisors, including representatives of agriculture, public and private institutions, health and nutrition, community advocates, the incorporated cities and towns and unincorporated portion of Napa County. Appointed members may establish working subcommittees with other community members as needed to achieve the goals established by the Council including, but not limited to, creating greater local food security, increased agricultural diversity and more reliable markets for small-scale farmers.

Napa County Local Food Advisory Council members will be appointed to serve four-year terms, although some initial appointments may be for a shorter period of time

to stagger the terms on the Council and provide for greater consistency of membership over time. The Napa County Local Food Advisory Council will have four regular meetings scheduled quarterly per year and may hold special meetings as needed. Additional time outside of regular meetings may include work on sub-committee assignments, but would be at the discretion of the individual member and the time commitment they are willing to make. Residents of Napa County who possess knowledge of or experience in local food production, sustainable farming practices, diet and nutrition or the retail food industries, and are interested in making a significant contribution to the purpose of the Napa County Local Food Advisory Council, are highly encouraged to submit an application for possible appointment by the Board of Supervisors. Applications may be found at the www.countyofnapa.org.

The County Executive Officer announces the following openings on the Napa County Local Food Advisory Council with terms of office to commence immediately:

- One (1) representative from the Board of Supervisors
- Five (5) representatives from the incorporated cities/town
- Three (3) representatives from agriculture
- One (1) individual representing public health and/or nutrition
- One (1) individual representing institutions
- One (1) individual representing marketing and/or distribution of agricultural products
- Three (3) representatives from the community at large
