**ISSUE:** Receive a presentation regarding an overview on the future development of a Sustainable Communities Strategy (SCS) required by Senate Bill 375.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Receive presentation and provide comments.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Senate Bill 375 became law in 2008 and is considered landmark legislation for California relative to land use, transportation and environmental planning. It calls for the development of a Sustainable Communities Strategy (SCS) in all metropolitan regions in California. Within the Bay Area, the law gives joint responsibility for the SCS to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG). These agencies will coordinate with the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (Air District) and the Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC).

The Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) has requested that each jurisdiction provide their local elected officials with an overview of the planning process that is currently underway by the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to develop a Sustainable Communities Strategy (SCS) for the Bay Area, consistent with Senate Bill 375. This presentation was presented to the Planning Commission on January 12, 2011. A copy of the background information regarding development of a SCS has been provided in Attachment A. It should be noted that this information will also be presented to the Community Resources Commission on January 19, 2011.

As indicated in Attachment A, regional agencies expect to release an Initial Vision Scenario in early February 2011. At this time, City staff will present a report to the Community Resources Commission, the Planning Commission and the City Council
