BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

It has come to staff's attention that the Mishewal Wappo Indian Tribe has entered into litigation with the federal government to obtain recognition as a tribe. While this tribe appears to be primarily based in Alexander Valley (Sonoma County), they have sought recognition in Lake, Sonoma and Napa Counties.

19 20 Since they did not go through an administrative appeals process with the Department of Interior (but went directly to federal court), the normal public noticing requirements did not occur. Accordingly, Napa County and the cities within the county have only recently become aware of this litigation. The concern is that if the tribe is recognized that they will seek land. If land so acquired obtains trust status with the Department of Interior, under California law, they can seek to establish Indian gaming as well as other commercial ventures without adherence to local general plans or zoning.

Napa County and most of the cities within the boundaries have entered into the federal lawsuit as interveners. Calistoga has not, due to concerns about expense and that the court hearing has been postponed to April 2011. The City has also been assured that Napa County interests in this matter will likely encompass the City's interests.

28 29 Napa County has requested that the city of Calistoga send letters to our congressional representatives opposing any federal settlement with the Mishewal Tribe that might result in trust land being established in Napa County and its cities. Attached is a draft of the letter to be sent to Senator Feinstein, with similar ones to be sent to Senator Barbara Boxer and Congressman Mike Thompson.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SEND LETTERS TO SENATORS DIANE FEINSTEIN AND BARBARA BOXER AND CONGRESSMAN MIKE THOMPSON REQUESTING OPPOSITION TO ANY FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SETTLEMENT WITH THE MISHEWAL WAPPO INDIAN TRIBE IN NAPA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the recommendations of the City Manager regarding the pending federal litigation regarding the Mishewal Wappo Indian Tribe's request to seek recognition as a tribe in Lake, Napa and Sonoma Counties; and

WHEREAS, due to concerns that recognition of the Mishewal Wappo Indian Tribe will lead to land acquisition that may achieve sovereign status, not subject to local general plan or zoning control or regulation; and

WHEREAS, there is concern that development on these lands, such as Indian Gaming, could have harmful effects on the City's and Napa Valley's open space and agricultural lands; and adversely impact the city of Calistoga's limited water and sewer supply.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Calistoga hereby directs the Mayor of the city of Calistoga to send a letter to Senators Diane Feinstein and Barbara Boxer and Congressman Mike Thompson requesting opposition to any federal government settlement with the Mishewal Wappo Indian Tribe in Napa County as generally set forth in Exhibit A to this resolution.
