Furthermore, each applicant must provide required insurance and comply with any terms or conditions applied to the permit. The applicant must also obtain an encroachment permit from Cal Trans.

Win-Rod Inc. and the Chamber of Commerce are planning their third classic car show for May 7, 2011 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. They are requesting the closure of Lincoln Avenue from Foothill to Fairway to place approximately 150 classic cars for viewing by the general public. The purpose of the closure is to ensure the safety of visitors walking among the cars on display and promote a festival atmosphere.

This closure would necessitate the placement of several detours not only for local traffic but for vehicles passing through to other destinations in Napa, Lake or Sonoma counties. The event manager will be required to notify all effected business in the area. The closure would eliminate all parking on Lincoln up to the 1500 block.
