The Hazardous Waste Collection Facility is for safe and legal disposal of unusable or unwanted hazardous products. Please remember to pack products carefully so they won't mix or spill. Transport in trunk if possible. The facility accepts all types of hazardous waste except: Radioactives • Explosives • Ammunition.

For highway safety, there is a legal limit of 15 gallons or 125 pounds of hazardous waste per trip.

**Households:** No appointment required; no fee. • **Businesses:** Appointment only; fee for service.

- Carburetor cleaners
- Batteries
- Used oil & oil filters

## HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL FOR BUSINESSES

### Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator Program

A business that generates less than 220 pounds or 27 gallons of hazardous waste a month is considered a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG). This program offers businesses an affordable way to comply with laws and regulations for disposal of hazardous waste. Appointments are required and there is a charge for this service. 

No radioactive materials, explosives, ammunition or PCBs. **You can only transport 15 gallons or 125 pounds maximum per trip.**

Anything that cannot be separated for reuse, recycling, or composting at the end of its life, and not accepted anywhere else covered in this recycling guide. Items will be charged a per ton fee and disposed of at a landfill.



This facility accepts at no fee: auto batteries, latex paint, antifreeze, used motor oil & filters. This is a California Certified Oil Collection Center that offers 16¢ per gallon for used oil.
