**SUBJECT:** Review and Amend Rules of Procedure

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# **ISSUES:**

Given the current economic climate the Planning and Building Department has substantially reduced the Building Officials working hours and staff is looking for opportunities to adjust the project workload to accommodate those hours.

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As per Board request and in an effort to streamline permitting processes staff presents the following proposal to allow the Building or Fire Code Official to administratively review and approve unreasonable hardship claims.

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### **BACKGROUND:**

In 2009 the Building Standards Advisory and Appeals Board adopted the Rules of Procedure.

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**Section V.2 MEETINGS**, the guidelines currently dictate the *Regular meetings of the Board will be held bimonthly at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Center 1307 Washington, unless otherwise determined by the Board or requested by the Building or Fire Code Official.* Staff is requesting consideration to reduce the frequency of those meetings to quarterly. Item 2 would be revised to read "Regular meetings of the Board will be held quarterly at 5:30 p.m. in the Community Center, 1307 Washington, unless otherwise determined by the Board or requested by the Building or Fire Code Official".

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**Section VII. PRESENTATIONS OR APPEAL HEARINGS**. During the regular meeting of September 30, 2010, by consensus of the Board it was requested that staff prepare a policy regarding unreasonable hardship claims to allow staff to administratively review and approve such requests in the future. Staff proposes to insert the following language related to unreasonable hardship claim appeals:

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- 1. The Building Official is authorized to review and approve unreasonable hardships that apply to structures that have been determined to be "historical" in nature and that contribute to the historic quality and character of the city.
  - 2. The applicant is eligible to challenge a determination of the Building or Fire Code Official regarding unreasonable hardship claims by submitting an appeal application. Appeal applications requesting the decision be heard by the Building Standards Advisory and Appeals Board must be submitted within ten (10) business days of the decision.
  - 3. Resume original language items 1 through 5.g. starting as item 3.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

- Approve amended language <u>Section V.2 MEETINGS</u> adjusting the meeting schedule to quarterly.
- Approve insertion of additional language to the Building Standards Advisory and Appeals Board Rules of Procedures, Section VII. PRESENTATIONS OR APPEAL HEARINGS authorizing review and approval of unreasonable hardship claim appeals by the Building or Fire Code Official; and allow for appeal of that decision to the BSAAB by the applicant if needed.
