**Chairman Coates** called for a motion to grant the appeal based upon the recommendation of Building Official Castle.

There was motion by **Member More**, seconded by **Member Shaw**, to grant the unreasonable hardship claim at 1347 Lincoln Avenue. **Motion carried:** 6-0-0-1.

 **Chairman Coates** requested that staff establish a policy regarding this unreasonable hardship claim example to allow staff in the future to administratively review and approve such requests. There was consensus by all **Board Members** for support of a policy.

**Building Official Castle** and **Director Gallina** indicated that a policy could be developed for action by the Board at their next meeting.

#### 7. GENERAL

 a. Recommendation to the City Council regarding adoption of the 2010 California Building Standards Code, Title 24, as adopted by the California State Building Standards Commission with amendments proposed by Staff.

**Building Official Castle** presented a brief overview of the new 2010 California Building Standards Code and indicated that there are no significant changes this time with the exception of the Green Building Standards Code Part 11 and Residential and Fire Codes. Castle also went over changes in the Plumbing Code as it related to Gray Water Standards as previous discussed by the Board.

 Fire Chief Campbell presented a brief overview of the proposed changes to the Fire Code related to sprinkler, photovoltaic and wildland wildfire interface regulations including additional recommended proposed changes that he wanted to include that were not addressed in the staff report.

There was Board discussion initiated by Board Member Coates regarding the need not to be too aggressive on Green Building Standard at this time due to the current economic climate.

The following motions were made concerning recommended adoption of the 2010 California Building Standards Codes.

1. There was a motion by **Member More**, seconded by **Member Valentine** recommend to the City Council adoption of the 2010 California State Building Standards Commission with recommendations proposed by staff and amended by the Fire Chief. **Motion carried: 7-0-0-0**.

2. There was a motion by **Member More**, seconded by **Member Valentine** recommend to the City Council adoption of Residential and Non-Residential Mandatory Measures only at this time due to the current economic climate. **Motion carried: 7-0-0-0**.
