- **ISSUE:** Consideration of a Resolution Designating one 15-minute Public Parking
- 3 Stall at 1473 Lincoln Avenue.
- 4 **RECOMMENDATION**: Adopt Resolution.
- 5 **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** The Silverado Pharmacy is the only full service
- 6 pharmacy business in Calistoga. It has recently relocated to 1473 Lincoln Avenue.
- 7 Brief drop-off and pick-up pharmacy orders, by those with limited mobility, are
- 8 complicated due to the scarcity of parking in that area and absence of a local drive-
- 9 through pharmacy.
- 10 Calistoga Municipal Code Section 10.36.080 authorizes the City Council to
- designate time limit public parking by resolution. Staff has received a request to
- designate one (1) parking stall from a 3-hour limit parking stall to a 15-minute limit
- parking stall. The 15-minute limit parking stall would not be designated for the
- pharmacy only, and could be used for any other visits of short duration.
- 15 Staff recommends that 15-minute parking limit signage and a green painted curb be
- established in the one (1) Northern-most diagonal parking stall before the Cal-Mart
- 17 driveway and the Fair Way intersection on Lincoln Ave. The City's maintenance
- agreement with Caltrans allows the City to effect this parking limit change within
- 19 Caltrans right-of-way.
- 20 Should the pharmacy business ever cease operation as a pharmacy or relocate,
- 21 Staff proposes that this parking stall would revert to a 3-hour limit parking stall.
- 22 **FISCAL IMPACT:**
- 23 The Public Works Department will purchase and install the post, hardware and sign
- 24 utilizing funds from the Streets, materials and supplies budget (01-4122-4401). It is
- 25 anticipated that costs including labor will be approximately \$500.00.
